On the ACROPOLIS you will visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the PROPYLAEA, the temple of ATHENA NIKE, the ERECHTEION and finally, the "harmony between matter and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the PARTHENON.</p> <p>Description for tour including the NEW Acropolis Museum: After this visit follows the visit of the new Acropolis Museum, located on the ancient road that led up to the "sacred rock" in classical times, housing every artifact found on the rock and on its feet, from the Greek Bronze Age to Roman and Byzantine Greece. A walk through its galleries is a walk through history - between the masterpieces of the Archaic and Classical periods, but also in the ancient neighbourhoods of Athens.</p>



A Neolithic lake settlement, 7000 years old, was discovered here and you will be able to stroll through and admire the reconstruction of the village which represents the contemporary museological concept. After Kastoria continue driving in the plateau of Western Macedonia and arrive in the picturesque town of Edessa. Here you can see the town's famous landmark, the waterfalls. Then, proceed to Pella, the capital of Alexander the Great. See the exquisite floor mosaics of the 4th century B.C. villas, in situ as well as in the local Museum. Return to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

Day 4: See in the morning the city that throughout the era of the Byzantine Empire, was the "co-reigning" city, second in population and prestige only to Constantinople. Visit unique monuments and feel the glorious Byzantine past in some of the oldest and most characteristic churches of Europe. Rest of the day free to enjoy time in the lively centre of the city. Dinner and overnight.

Day 5: Drive to Vergina, to live the experience of a visit to the unique Museum, created in the Great Tumulus covering the royal tombs of Macedonia. Day 1: Leave by the coastal road to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive on and visit the Theatre of Epidauros famous for its remarkable acoustics. Then proceed to the town of Nafplion (short stop) and drive on to Mycenae and visit the Archaeological Site and the Tomb of Agamemnon. Then proceed to Naoussa, to a site of exceptional beauty and importance: Aristotle's School, the impressive scenery where the great philosopher taught "the doctrines of morals and politics" to Alexander and the Macedonia youths. Only a few miles away is picturesque Edessa, where we see the town's famous landmark the Waterfalls. Then comes Pella, the capital of Alexander the Great. See the exquisite floor mosaics of the 4th century B.C. villas, in situ as well as in the new museum. Return to Thessaloniki for dinner & overnight.

Day 6: See in the morning the city that throughout the era of the Byzantine Empire, was the co-reigning city, second in population and prestige only to Constantinople. Visit unique monuments and feel the glorious Byzantine past in some of the oldest and most characteristic churches of Europe. Rest of the day free to enjoy time in the lively center of the city. Dinner and overnight.

Day 7: Drive to Vergina, to live the experience of a visit to the unique Museum, created in the Great Tumulus covering the royal tombs of Macedonia. See the astonishing findings from the tomb of King Philip II, Alexander's father, and feel the thrill of the greatest discovery of the 20th century. After the visit we shall start driving south and through Thessaly, Lamia, Thermopylae (see the Leonidas' monument) and Thebes, arrive in Athens late in the afternoon.
