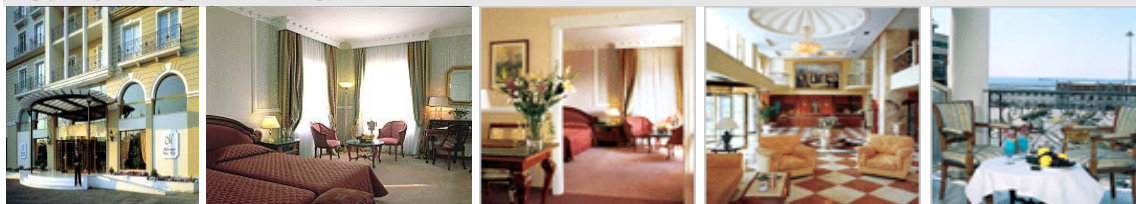


THESSALONIKI

Thessaloniki, the second largest city in Greece with a population of 1,000,000 inhabitants, is one of the oldest cities in Europe. It stretches over twelve kilometers in a bowl formed by low hills facing a bay that opens into the Gulf of Thermaikos. It was founded about 315 B.C., on a site of old prehistoric settlements going back to 2300 B.C., by Cassander, King of Macedonia, and was named after his wife, Thessaloniki, sister of Alexander the Great. Since then, Thessaloniki has become the chief city of Macedonia and its most important commercial port.

LOCAL TOURS - Brief descriptions

1. Thessaloniki Sightseeing

First we will proceed to show you the White Tower - the symbol of the city - followed by a visit to the Archaeological Museum. Afterwards we will pass by the Fairgrounds and drive through the university area, the Citadel and the city walls from where a marvellous view of Thessaloniki can be seen. We will then visit St. Dimitrios' Byzantine church, as well as the Galerius Arch and the Rotunda Monument.

2. Petralona Cave

We visit the famous Cave of Petralona where the bones of various ancient animals have been found, which are aged about 500.000 years as well as the well-known Archanthropos- Skull which is about 200.000 years old. You can also see the impressive stalactites and stalagmites as well as the traces of the first fire lit by man. You will also have the chance to see the evaluation of the prehistoric human life, e.g. the tools that were used every day.

3. Olympus, Home of Gods

We drive west to Dion, an ancient site where the twelve mythical Gods were worshipped. After visiting the site we will have time for a brief lunch break. Continuing south, we arrive at the foot of Mount Olympus, to Litohoron Village, where our guided walk will begin. Breathe the fresh mountain air, admire the natural beauty, whilst walking through unspoilt forests to Ainipeas valley. Returning to Litohoron we will have time to relax over a coffee or to explore this picturesque village.

4. Sithonia tour

Enjoy the magic landscape and the quiet sandy gulfs. In the picturesque village of Neos Marmaras, you will have the chance for a break, either for a stroll in the centre and a shopping tour, or enjoy a coffee. Following we drive along the East Coast of Sithonia, from where you may see Mount Athos. Further, we reach Sarti, where you will have free time for lunch and swimming. This is a good chance to see the marvellous Sithonia peninsula from its brightest side.

5. Alexander the Great

We will drive across beautiful Macedonia, which is called the "Garden of Europe". First we proceed to Vergina, the place of the Royal Tombs, where we visit the King's mausoleum and the famous museum with finds of the Tombs of King Philippos II the father of Alexander the Great. You will have free time for lunch. We continue to Pella, the ancient capital town of Macedonia and native town of Alexander the Great. The small museum gives you the chance to see findings aged from 4th century BC.

6. Mount Athos tour

The cruise will take you along the western coast of Mount Athos. Sailing you will have the opportunity to view and photograph Europe's most unique Monk's Republic with its impressive Byzantine Monasteries. To this day 1.700 monks still live under strict rule on the Holy Mountain, with no woman ever being allowed to set foot there. The boat will cruise along the western coast to Ouranoupolis for a stop of approximately two hours. In this quaint fishing village, you will have the chance to eat in one of the small taverns, go for a swim, or to shop.

Here you will see the Byzantine Tower and perhaps have the opportunity to admire the traditional method used to make hand-woven carpets. Depart Ouranoupolis for the return trip to Ormos Panagias.

7. Meteora tour

A highlight of your stay in Greece will be a visit to the Meteora Monasteries. We will travel along the coast where you shall view Mount Olympus, the mythical residence of the twelve Gods. En route, there will be a 20-minute coffee break in the scenic Valley of Tempa and then on to Kalambaka traveling through Larissa and Trikala for an optional lunch at the foot of the cliffs. Following lunch, there will be a brief sightseeing tour of Kalambaka. We will then leave for Meteora, a geological miracle which must actually be seen to be believed. We shall visit two of the fabulous monasteries perched high upon the steep rocks. Each monastery possesses a vast richness of frescoes, icons and intricate carvings.

Important notice: For entering the monasteries, appropriate clothing is required. Ladies must **not** wear short skirts and must have long sleeves. Men are not allowed to wear shorts. On our return trip, there will be a coffee break in the Valley of Tempa.
